

# Go faster and higher with powerful sails!



In order to achieve full performance with your *Vertech Jib*, use a downhaul! Compare these two pictures and note how the downhaul is in action in the right picture, tightening the leech of the jib.



The selftacker *Vertech Jib* has an utmost capacity. The sail area is 20% larger than a standard selftacking jib. The battens are vertical and parallel to the forstay to support the roach that overlaps the front of the mast. *Vertech Jib* fully controls the airflow between the mainsail and headsail. The mainsail is equipped with fullybattens supporting the roach.



In conclusion:  
  
Using sails with efficient construction, intelligent design along with a light-weight, strong and durable material, your boat will go closer to wind and perform higher speeds!

A test was performed with two identical boats (Hanse 342/05) in the late summer of 2005. The owners had been sailing side by side with standard sails delivered with the boats through the summer and considered themselves equal in performance. The trial began with focus on the *Vertech Jib* only. The breeze was close to picking a reef, but the decision to keep a full sail area was made.
